Applicants should bring ten examples of their work to the interview, with two dimensional work matted, mounted, or framed. The portfolios will be held by the Committee until all interviews are completed. Portfolios should be picked up Tuesday, April 24 or Wednesday, April 25.

Certificates of Award will be presented at the Delaware Arts Festival on Saturday, May 19, 2018 at noon. Winners are expected to attend. The three Scholarship winners' work, shown at the interview, will be exhibited at the Delaware County District Library in downtown Delaware during June, 2018, with specific dates to be determined.

The winners will be recognized at the Delaware Arts Festival on Saturday, May 19 and their work will be exhibited at the Delaware County District Library in Delaware during June 2018.

The scholarships will be awarded to the students who, in the judgement of the Arts Festival Association Scholarship Committee, rank the highest among the applicants in terms of achievement and promise in the visual arts.
